BEGINNERS ———
Beginners enjoy the vast and relatively flat expanses of the Van Norden Meadow, with scenic laps around the Bill Patterson Loop. Beginners can also explore trail systems directly from the Summit Station Lodge, including favorites Big Ben and James Joy.



INTERMEDIATES ———
Intermediates appreciate the gentle encouragement of Reindeer, Hellman Way and Point Mariah, which lead to one of the most scenic vistas in all of Tahoe.



EXPERTS ———
Experts looking for a longer endurance outing love the challenging steep slopes and distances skating Wagon Train and Horseshoe Loop to Devils Peak. For further information on recommended trails, be sure to stop in and speak to one of our friendly and helpful staff members at Summit Station.

While we welcome snowshoers, we request that you stay to the side of the trails and off the tracks and middle lanes; these areas are designed for track and skate skiers. DO NOT SKI OFF GROOMED TRAILS! Grooming machines may be operating on trails at any time, please be alert and use caution.

TRAIL PASSES
BEFORE purchasing a trail pass and going skiing, please read the information on this map carefully and check weather and track conditions. All trails may not be open (especially during adverse conditions) and grooming quality can be affected by temperature, wind, rain and falling snow. Please read the safety information.

TRACK SYSTEM
Entry is not permitted onto the track system before or after posted operating hours. Weather Reports and Track Conditions are available at Royal Gorge's trailheads and where trail passes are sold. Royal Gorge reserves the right to close trail systems due to adverse snow and weather conditions.
